

Your tithes, offerings, and donations to College Street Baptist can now be made online. Tithing and donating have never been easier. It's quick, easy and secure and you can use debit or credit or check cards, or checking account. Just go to our website at www.collegestreetbaptist.org for further information and instructions.

Online giving is not replacing any of the traditional ways we already give, but is an additional option to those who prefer to make their donations by computer, cell phone or other mobile devices. College Street is using a church donation system provided by the Easy Tithe corporation. *EasyTithe* is church specific and is currently used by hundreds of churches across the nation.

You can make a regularly scheduled contribution or you can specify recurring donations. You can specify whether the contribution should go to the general budget or to designated categories. A credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover) or a debit card can be used as well as a regular checking account. The process is secure and confidential and you will have continual access to your giving records.

Hello CSBC!

Can you believe that Christmas is next week? I love this time of year! A holiday project that I took on this year was volunteering to direct "A Charlie Brown Christmas" at Faith Christian School. Most of you know the story of Charlie Brown's infamous quest to find out what the true meaning of Christmas is and his constant discouragement when the people around him only seem to care about money and gifts and commercialism. My family has watched "A Charlie Brown Christmas" every Christmas Eve as long as I can remember and directing the play this year really got me thinking about the story. The passage in Luke 2 that Linus shares with Charlie Brown is even more timeless and more applicable to our world today than people realize.

However, like Charlie Brown's friends, we are often guilty of getting caught up in the busyness and the stress of the holiday season. We often, like Lucy, Sally, Snoopy, and all the others try to make Christmas complicated but the message of Jesus coming to earth isn't complicated. Neither is it glamorous or fancy, similar to the tiny tree Charlie picks out that no one wanted. Even though there were tall, colorful, beautiful trees, Charlie Brown picked a small, twiggy pine tree. Jesus picks us too. Even when we don't feel valuable or special, He picked us by dying for us on the cross. Even though there were more glamorous and ostentatious ways to come to Earth, He came as a helpless baby. The angels presented themselves first to outcasts like the shepherds, instead of fancy or overly-religious people, because God came for everyone! As you enjoy traditions and special memories with your family this season, remember the TRUE story of Christmas, which Linus shares humbly and simply, remembering, "That's what Christmas is all about, Charlie Brown."

It is such a blessing to share another Christmas season with my church family at CSBC! I am so thankful for each of you!
